Purpose

GDSI, **the Global Decision Support Initiative** is DTU's *new cross-disciplinary* competence centre for sustainable decision support *combining* quantitative risk and sustainability assessment.

The purpose of this meeting is to raise knowledge about GDSI internally at DTU and potentials for strengthening existing research areas. For the time being the initiative includes six departments, but in 2016 GDSI opens up for a 2nd phase including more institutes and centres at DTU.

The GDSI was initiated through DTU's investment in six 3-year postdocs, a substantial engagement by a number of professors from DTU Management, DTU Civil Engineering, DTU Compute, DTU Food, DTU Transport and DTU Environment, and a director.
